Beefeater London

Served with Fevertree Aromatic Tonic Water and a slice of orange

A classic and superb London dry noted for its characteristic citrus notes as much as it's juniper and subtle spice from cardamom and angelica. These strong aromas and flavours are enhanced with Fevertree's Aromatic Tonic.

Brockmans London

Served with Fever-tree Lemon Tonic Water, a slice of orange and two blueberries

An instant hit for those trying out gin for the first time. A smooth berry forward gin and the hero of our Bramble cocktail! The sharpness of Fever-tree's Lemon Tonic perfectly complements the sweet berry profile of this gin.

Boe Violet Stirling

Served with Fever-tree Elderflower Tonic, two blueberries and a blackberry

This unmistakable vibrant gin has found its way o to many gantries over the years. Floral, sweet and a flavour profile like no other. Fever-tree's Elderflower Tonic bring out the complex bouquet of this unique gin.

Botanist Islay

Served with Fever-tree Tonic, a lemon slice and a sprig of fresh thyme or mint

From the makers of Bruichladdich the famous unpeated Islay malt comes a seriously top tier dry gin. This is a true artisanal gin with much of the distilled ingredients foraged from around the island most notably coming through is the chamomile, spearmint and juniper. Fever-tree Tonic elevates the aroma and profile of this gin perfectly.

Rock Rose Caithness

Served with Fever-tree Mediterranean Tonic and a sprig of toasted rosemary

At the forefront of small batch Scottish distillers is Dunnet Bay Distillers and their flagship gin. This gin is truly unique from their local botanical "Rhodiola rosea" which lends a soft rose aroma to an overall complex and balanced dry gin. Sea Buckthorn plays a role here to bring out the gentle citric notes. Fever-tree's Mediterranean Tonic works perfectly to bring out the citric and herbaceous qualities of the gin.

Hendricks Girvan

Served with Fever-tree Refreshingly Light Tonic and a cucumber ribbon

Arguably the gin that launched gins into the forefront. Still one of the smoothest and lightest gins on the market. Rose petals and cucumber play the leading role here as opposed to juniper found in traditional London Drys. The contemporary classic. Fever-tree's Refereshingly Light Tonic allows the more subtle flavours and aromas to come through.
